St. KURIAKOSE ELIAS CHAVARA (Our Founder) 1805 - 1871

St. Kuriakose Elias Chavara was born at Kainakary, Kerala. He was a great visionary and a saintly priest who ventured into many humanitarian activities in his lifetime. He is the forerunner in the field of education and he is also the founder of CMI* Congregation, the first indigenous religious congregation in India.



He was a social reformer who started

Sanskrit schools for the low caste people and set up old age homes, orphanages and many other socially oriented projects for the people in need.

Foreseeing the role of communication media, he established a printing press at Mannanam. He was a great orator and administrator. He was appointed as the Vicar General of the Syro-Malabar Church at a time when it had no Bishop of its own.

His commitment in protecting the downtrodden is well known. Above all, he was a sage who lived a life of prayer and commitment to the society, It was really a proud moment for Indians when he was declared a saint on 23 November 2014 by Pope Francis.

- 5. No pupil should disturb other classes at work on the flimsy plea of taking pencil or book on loan from his/her friend.
